

Reason for opening: Change of Management with deeper focus on work culture, safety, up-time and preventive service. Maintenance and safety issue prevention are high priorities in this position. Focus also on improved documentation, reporting and workflow. More emphasis on customer service.

At Tornio Shredder the main task is to shred/fragment various scrap into high-value cooling scrap to be used in the steel making process by the steel mill. With our shredder driven by a 4000hp motor we produce 11-12% of the total steel consumption for the steel mill, and we operate 24/7/365.


